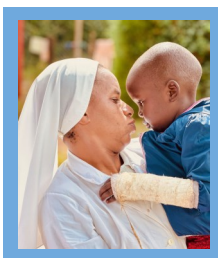

- **The gift of the new OVEN!** We are baking bread and our meals every day! God bless you always!
- **The new, large incinerator** completed in March through your funding has made our compound more efficient with lower environmental impact and the recycling of clean ash for natural fertilizer.
- The **“Chicken Coop”** project was launched in February. We added 100 laying hens to our flock. This has benefited our children more than ever before due to the increase of protein in their diet.
- Your support for our free **Catholic Pharmacy and Healthcare Clinic** has made it much easier for us to meet the needs of our people who dearly need medical attention and medications they cannot afford. May God bless you!
- **The fencing for the important “Bore Hole Project” was provide through you!** Thank you!

WE NOW HAVE A NEW DREAM. The new bore hole will now bring fresh water to our mission creating the opportunity **to build a Greenhouse and irrigation system** for our two acres of farm land.
